

Stair-climber steps up to world record

Steve Silva ends his record-breaking continuous climb of the stairs at the Westin Peachtree Plaza this morning (above), and hugs supporters (right) after climbing 62 flights 39 times. It took 9 hours, 52 minutes and 45 seconds to climb 26,676 feet, beating the record of 25,520 feet in 10 hours, 32 minutes and 24 seconds listed in the Guinness Book of World Records.
